Co-op Interview Day

 need both (the entry ticket and validation pass) to exit.

By creating job postings prior to the fair, students gain a better understanding of openings and get to know your recruiting needs. Employers registered to conduct Interviews Only must create a job posting in order to receive applicants and schedule interviews.
- Set-up Career Fair Plus Recruiter Account We continue to partner with the Career Fair Plus software
 to support a mobile-friendly information delivery about your company, hiring requirements and event
 information. In addition to general company info, you, the recruiter, can opt to collect resumes via the
 CF+ Resume Drop option. Employer representatives who registered for Co-op Days will receive an
 email from CF+ with links and instructions. If you are new to CF+, feel free to review <u>their Step-by-Step
