- **One-on-One Writing Consultations**  
Work with a trained writing consultant on any document from any discipline.

- **Special Programming**  
Participate in programming developed specifically for graduate students and their writing.
- **OWL (Online Writing Lab)**  
Look over handouts, workshops, and vidcasts on writing-related and graduate writing topics.
- **Consultations for Instructors**  
Collaborate with Writing Lab staff to incorporate writing into disciplinary coursework.
- **Support for International Students**  
Practice spoken English by attending weekly conversation groups.

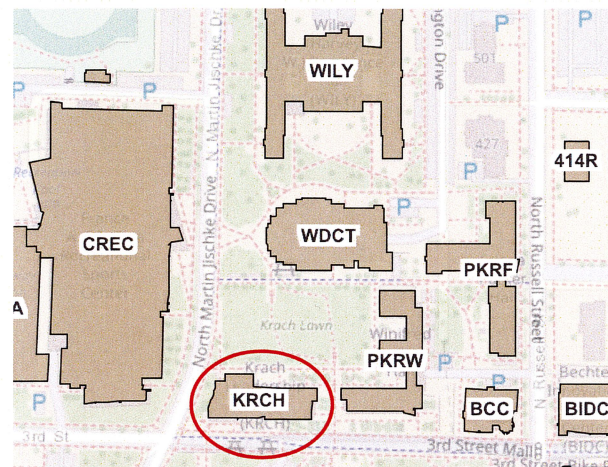

- Work at any stage of the process: starting the project, writing a rough draft, improving an existing draft, or polishing a final draft.

- Discuss your writing task, and decide what you want to focus on.
