Graduate students had a median hourly wage of **\$32.23** and **undergraduate students** had a median hourly wage of **\$22.00**.

Highest hourly wage reported was **\$55 for graduate students** and **\$46.88 for undergraduates**. The lowest was \$14.50 for undergraduates.

Hourly wages paid to Professional Practice students are determined by employers and vary in a number of ways.

Location, discipline, employer, job performance, and local cost of living all play a factor in determining a student's salary.

Our intention is for Professional Practice Programs to provide students with meaningful work experience; we feel strongly that our students should be paid accordingly.
